ADMINISTRATIVE SPECIAL USE PERMIT

PURPOSE: To request an Administrative Special Use Permit to establish a Wireless Communication Facility (WCF) in the City of Coronado.

AUTHORITY: Coronado Municipal Code Title 86, Chapter 86.55.

NOTES:

- **1.** Application packages for an Administrative Special Use Permit shall be filed with the City of Coronado Community Development Department. Faxed applications will not be accepted.
- **2.** Application packages must be submitted inclusive of all attachments and submittal requirements. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- **3.** An Administrative Special Use Permit filing fee is not required when filing the initial application. A \$77 Public Notification fee will be required at the time of the initial submittal, along with a complete notification packet.
- **4.** The Community Development Director considers a request for an Administrative Special Use Permit and renders a decision, unless a request for hearing is received (see Note 5). The Director's action is appealable to the Planning Commission in accordance with Chapter 1.12 of the Coronado Municipal Code.
- **5.** If a request for hearing is received, the Planning Commission shall render a decision at a noticed public hearing and the applicant shall submit fees for a Minor Special Use Permit and any required deposit for an independent consultant review as determined by the Director.
- **6.** In order to be reviewed for processing, applications must be deemed complete. The City has 30 days to determine the application complete or incomplete.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Completed Application Form, Filing Fee, and public notification package.
- **2.** Copy of deed and Preliminary Title Report identifying easements or restrictions placed on uses of property.
- **3.** Description of proposed use including, but not limited to: on-site activities, operating characteristics, height of facility, design of facility, ancillary equipment, amount of grading proposed, linear feet of trenching, estimated noise.
- **4.** Completed California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documentation.
- **5.** The following attachments:
 - 1 copy of plans (22" x 34" in size), folded to 11" x 17"
 - 8 copies of project plans printed on 11" x 17"
 - O Plans shall include the name and address of property owner; name and address of applicant proposing use; proposed use and address of property; north arrow and scale; plot plan with

property dimensions including existing buildings on the site, setbacks, structures to be demolished/new buildings to be constructed; exterior elevations; landscape plan, existing/proposed parking; proposed walls/fences

- Complete project description, including reason for additional facility in the area
- Assessor map/aerial map which labels the proposed facility and surrounding neighborhood/streets
- Photo-simulations (existing and proposed)
- A coverage map (demonstrating lack of coverage)
- If the WCF is not in a preferred area, an Alternative Site Analysis (demonstrating why the facility cannot be placed in a preferred location)
- one digital set of project plans and one digital set of photographs of project site
